

LABORATORY TECHNICIAN POSITION AT THE QUANTUM BEAMS & SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS GROUP

The **Quantum Beams & Sustainable Materials Group** at CFM is offering a Laboratory technician (2 months) position starting in November 2023, to work under the supervision of Prof. Felix Fernandez-Alonso. The position is part of the I+D+I project PID2020-114506GB-I00 funded by MCIN/ AEI /10.13039/501100011033, to support our research program focused on the design, preparation and execution of experimental campaigns at large international facilities for materials research.

The selected candidate will be hired by the Research Association MPC - Materials Physics Center. The salary will be 17.398,20 euros a year before taxes.

The Quantum Beams & Sustainable Materials Group at the Materials Physics Center makes extensive use of beams of quantum particles like neutrons or photons in tandem with computational materials modelling to interrogate, understand, and design novel functional materials for energy applications and sustainability. This research program is heavily underpinned by the development of new techniques and methodologies for materials discovery, both in our laboratories as well as in close collaboration with leading neutron and X-ray laboratories from around the globe.

Candidates must hold a BSc degree or equivalent in Chemistry, Physics, Materials Science or related discipline. Prior exposure to the technical requirements associated with the measurement of thermophysical properties and/or the use of radiation-scattering techniques (X-ray, neutron, etc) would be an asset.
